



The article describes how the McAdams were investigated for allegedly raping and murdering a woman named Marjeanne Johnson-McAdams. It then goes on to include an admission by Michael Sibbitt, who also worked at the paper. 73m: John McAdams, the St. Louis Post-Dispatch columnist who wrote about St. Louis Mayor Francis Slay's son, is charged with murder in the death of Marjeanne Johnson-McAdams. He pleaded not guilty in federal court last week and is charged in connection with Johnson's slaying. 73n: Police chief Richard Duncan says it is possible that the killing of Johnson-McAdams could be caused by foul play. Police spokesman John Mullen says those details have yet to be determined. 730: "I know we're not gonna forget this," St. Louis City Police Sgt. Steve McCrae says after the McAdams were dropped off at a McDonalds, just outside of St. Louis, shortly before 1 p.m. Johnson-McAdams was last seen leaving that restaurant in her Honda Accord. Three days after her death, police arrested her alleged killer, John McAdams. 77b: Police have arrested five people in connection with the death of Johnson-McAdams. Police said that on Friday, Nov. 14, at about 8:40 p.m., Johnson-McAdams had disappeared from the intersection of South 13th Street and North Central Boulevard. The driver and passenger of McAdams' vehicle, identified as 19-year-old Michael Sibbitt, were all arrested. It is understood from the St. Louis Dispatch that police found an air rifle on Johnson-McAdams' Honda Accord on Saturday, Nov. 15, after they received an anonymous tip of a possible abduction of a girl from that area. Johnson-McAdams, whose body was found in a canal near her home, left early that morning from McDonald's on Southwest Washington Street, where she reportedly dropped off her father. The last known contact she had with Johnson-McAdams was about 9 a.m., when she texted her father, McAdams wrote, "Please be home before 9 and I'll pick you up from school." "Please leave everything here," she wrote.
